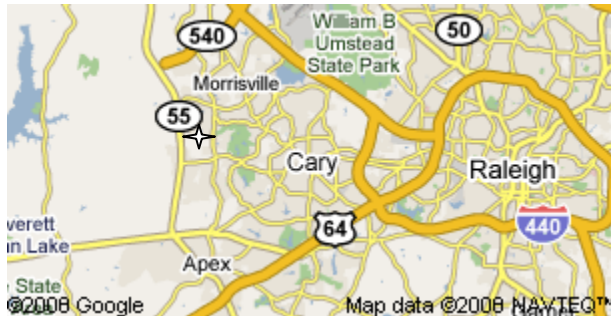
- **Happy Hour:** A weekly feature is Friday night Happy Hour, followed by Game Time where the choice of games varies or come share your favorite.
